MEETING OF THE COUNCIL

The Chair has decided to convene an extraordinary meeting of the Council to be held on Wednesday 26 August 2026 at 7.00pm in the Council Chamber located at the rear of the Llandough Memorial Hall. The agenda will focus on the following urgent matters:

1. To receive and consider the minutes of the meeting of the Lewis Road Reserve Allotments Working Party held on 30 July 2026 (Attached) – The decision required relates to the appointment of a planning consultant to take forward the possibility of being granted deemed planning consent for the development of the site.
2. To receive an oral update on the water escape at Brook Green.
3. To consider the offer of a licence to use the redundant tennis court as a bird sanctuary which will involve payment of legal costs to the Vale of Glamorgan Council of £405.17.
4. To receive an update on the flailing of the perimeter of the reserve allotments site.
